Office - Is open 8am – 6pm weekdays and 8:30am – 6pm on weekends and public holidays. For after-hours emergencies please call 0421 906 649.

BBQs and the Camp Kitchen - Available for your use and enjoyment! They are regularly cleaned but please look after them and keep them as clean and tidy as possible so others may use and enjoy them too! Camp Kitchen is open from 8am to 9pm.

Rubbish and Recycling - Bins are provided for your convenience, please take advantage of them.

Car Parking - There is only room allowed for one car per site. For additional parking space please enquire at reception.

TV - Reception is digital. For best results, keep your aerial vertical and point toward Peake Terrace (south).

Things to do - There is so much to see and do around Waikerie and the Riverland! We have brochures for you to browse in reception. Alternatively, visit our website and check our 'things to do' page!

Speed - Walking pace only for the comfort and safety of all guests.

Boom Gates - Boom gates allow one car at a time only, please use one pin code per car rather than try to follow someone through.

Noise - After 10pm noise should be kept to a minimum, please be respectful of fellow guests!

Check Out - Is 10am please.

Visitors - Are more than welcome! Please have guests sign in at the office. Visitor parking is next to the office.

Pets - We are more than happy to welcome your furry companions! Pets are only allowed when you are staying on a site – unfortunately we do not allow animals in our cabins. For the benefit of all guests (including your pets) we do ask that dogs are kept on a lead at all times, they are cleaned up after and are not left alone at the park – if you pop out, take them with you! Alternatively we can recommend a local kennel that can look after them for you.

Sites - If you are on a grass site, please do not place annex flooring down. This will help us keep the grass healthy.

Appliances - For safety reasons, please ensure all electrical goods such as air conditioners, stoves etc are switched off when you are not in your accommodation.

Fire Regulations - Please note all van drawbars must face the roadway.

Smoking - Smoking is not permitted in any of the cabins or inside other park facilities – strictly outside only. Please use the cigarette bins provided.
